History of Cricket

Cricket has been originated in southeast England, it became the country's national sport in the 18th century and has developed globally in the 19th and 20th centuries. International matches have been played since 1844 and Test cricket began recognized, in 1877. We also have a women's cricket match.

Types of Cricket Matches

There are three formats of cricket played at the international level

1. Test matches
2. One-Day Internationals
3. Twenty20 Internationals.

These matches are played under the rules and regulations approved by the International Cricket Council.

Cricket is a professional outdoor sport played by people from different countries, especially at National and International levels. Cricket is a sport which is played between two teams with eleven players each.

In these two teams, one team chooses batting while another team is fielding. Runs are scored by hitting the ball, which is thrown by a bowler from the fielding team to a player from the batting team, across the boundary. The empire gives the score.

The wickets are sets at each end of a rectangle-shaped called 'the pitch', which is 22 yards long. The area of play is a 30-yard circle inside the cricket ground or stadium. Two players get a chance of batting one player at one end of the pitch while another player at another end of the pitch. when a player is "out", a new teammate will replace by the same team. when a team is "not-out" players left to bat get the chance to score.

Here are some rules in Cricket Match

There are two teams. The team bowling has 11 players on the field. The team batting has two players, one at each end of the pitch.

The rest of the batting team members are off the field.

Runs are taken by the batting team when the ball is bowled by the fielding team. It may be run or six or four.

If the bowler bowls the ball across the line, then it is called a no-ball.

The captain of the bowling team chooses a bowler from his team, the other players are called 'fielders'.

The bowler tries to aim the ball to the wickets which are called stumps

There are two empires on either side of wickets. The empire decision regarding score is final.

The bowler runs towards the wicket and bowls towards the batsman at the other wicket. One of the fielders, called the 'wicket-keeper', stands behind the wicket to catch the ball. Other fielders chase the ball hit by the batsmen.

If the ball rolls or bounces out, whether or not the batter hit it, it counts as four runs.

An 'over' is six balls, meaning he bowls six times. Then another player becomes the bowler for the next over, and so on. The same bowler cannot bowl two overs one after the other.

If the ball leaves the field after being hit without bouncing then it counts as 6.
